# Advanced Care Planning in the Fanconi Outpatient Clinic

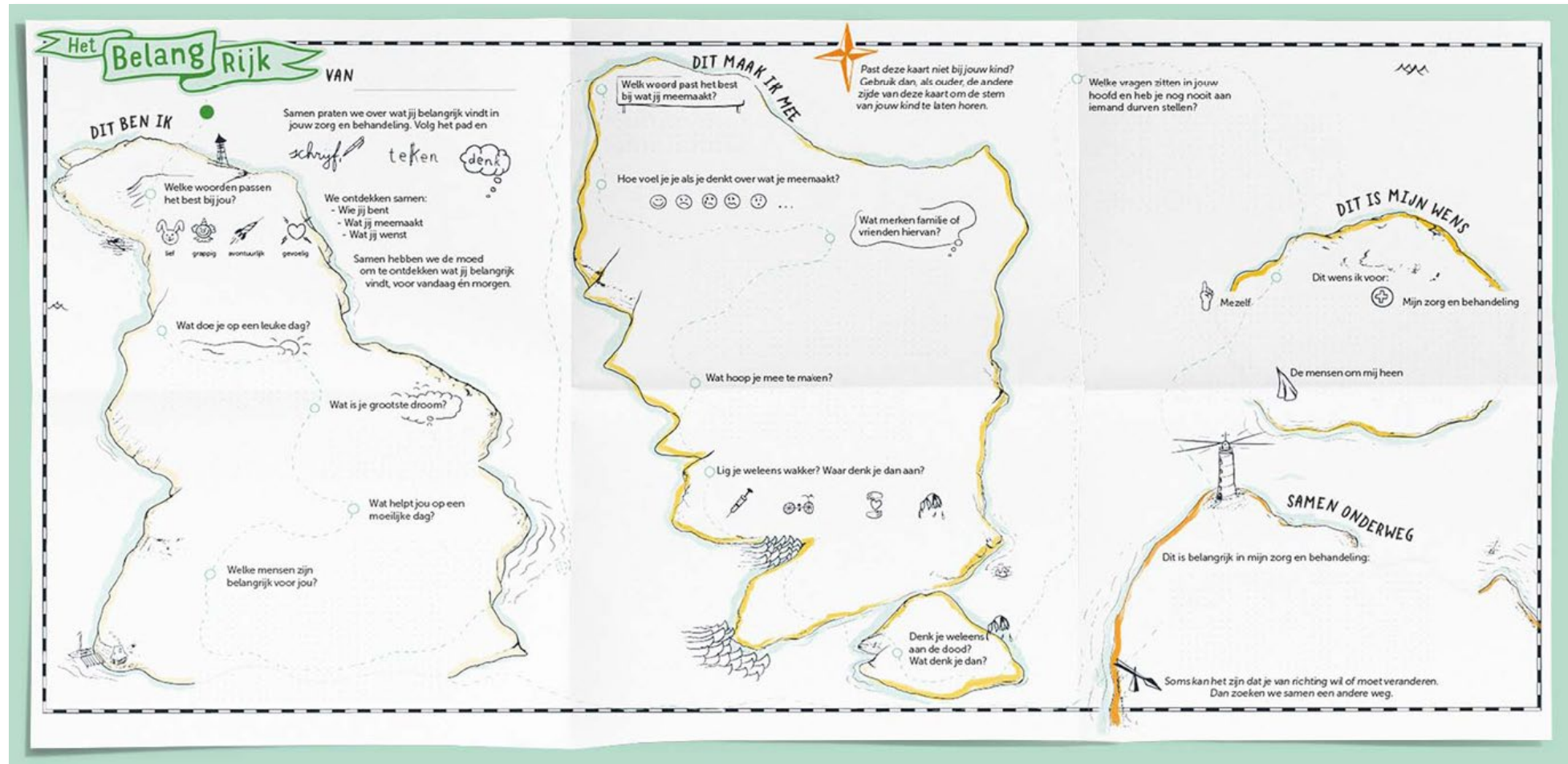
## Advanced Care Planning

- Structured communication process
- Values, goals, preferences
- Now and in the future

## Timing

- 1 year after diagnosis or HSCT
- Age 10-12 years
- Age 16 years





## Advanced Care Planning

- Creates **dedicated space** for understanding family needs
- Helps healthcare professionals **identify prevalent issues**
- Enhances **patient-centered care**

*Structured ACP conversations help to create a shared understanding and to set practical care priorities for patient, parent and caregiver*
